ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018- 2

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY IN THE TOWN OF  
CARLISLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Carlisle (the "Town"), County of Sullivan, State of Indiana,

WITNESSETH:

THIS ORDINANCE, made and established by the Town in a regularly scheduled meeting of the Town Board to ordain and regulate the burning of trash and to collect monies for the violation of the same, pursuant to the Town's authority to create ordinances relating to the public health and safety of the Town and pursuant to Ind. Code 36-1-3-4 and Ind. Code 13-31-2-1.

NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CARLISLE, Sullivan County, Indiana, that this ordinance is hereby adopted this 5 day of JUNE 2018. Regulation of the burning of trash within the Town of Carlisle shall be as follows:

**1.00 DEFINITIONS.** The terms defined herein shall have the following meanings unless another is expressly utilized.

1. Trash. The term "Trash" shall mean all non-decaying-solid and semi solid items, except for paper products, wood, charcoal, and yard waste.
2. Yard Waste. The term "Yard Waste" shall mean leaves; hedge, shrub, bush or tree trimmings; limbs or sticks from trees, bushes, shrubs, or hedges, whether dead or alive; and other organic matter normally associated with yard and garden maintenance.

**1.01 BURNING TRASH.** No person shall start, kindle, cause, allow, or maintain a fire that burns trash.

**1.02 EXEMPTIONS.** This ordinance does not prohibit the burning of charcoal, clean wood, paper products, and other cooking fuels customarily used in an outdoor grill, traditional food cooking devices, or campfires.

ORDINANCE 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-2 AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE BURNING OF TRASH IN THE TOWN OF CARLISLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Carlisle, Indiana, now wishes to Amend Ordinance 2018-\_\_\_, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Carlisle, Indiana, finds a continued need for the regulation of the burning of trash in Carlisle, Indiana,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN CONCIL OF THE TOWN OF CARLISLE INDIANA, THAT:

Ordinance 2018-\_\_\_, Article 1.02, Exemptions, is amended to read as follows:

"This ordinance does not prohibit the burning of charcoal, clean wood, paper products, and other cooking fuels customarily used in an outdoor grill, traditional food cooking devices, or campfires. All residential and farm burning shall be conducted during daylight hours and shall be extinguished at sunset. Burn piles shall not be smoking or smoldering overnight. No burning shall be conducted during unfavorable meteorological conditions such as high winds. No burning is permitted on Town streets, alleys, or rights-of-way."

This ordinance is hereby adopted and passed by the Town Council of the Town of Carlisle this 6 day of JAN, 2020, 2019 and shall become effective two weeks after the date of entry into the Town's Ordinance Book.
